History

We were formally set up in 1982 but our roots go back to April 1970, making us one of the longest surviving LGBT groups in the UK. In the 1970's the group campaigned strongly for Homosexual Equality, and later it was reorganised to be more of an independent support and social group covering Bristol, Bath and surrounding areas. Our Rainbow Café was set up in April 1982 and still opens for 2 hours each and every Saturday morning.
